The desired certificate is as follows:-

- (1) No. of institutions already existing in the state. 9
- (2) No. of seats available or No. of dental surgeons being produced annually
: Seat available 780 in the state including both of state government & S.F.I.
- (3) No. of dental surgeons registered with the State Dental Council
: 2078 up to 31-3-08
- (4) No. of dental surgeons in Government service : 188
- (5) No. of Government posts vacant and those in rural / difficult areas.
:36 Most of them in rural / difficult area.
- (6) No. of dental surgeons registered with Employment Exchange - Nil
- (7) Dental Surgeon population ratio in the State.
:1:80,000 (WHO report dental population ratio) against desired ratio
1:10,000
- (8) How the establishment of the college would resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified dental personnel in the state and improve the availability of such dental manpower in the state.



: Establishing this college local personnel would be readily available who would efficiently serve the institution / public at large. Hence the problem of deficiency of qualified dental personnel and manpower would be solved to some extent.

- (10) Full justification for opening of the proposed college.

Justification :

Ahmedabad is the largest city in the State of Gujarat & the 7th largest urban agglomeration in India, with a population of 56 lacs in 2008. The city has witnessed the establishment of scientific and service industries, the expansion of the information technology sector and significant improvement in transportation and communication. Industrialization and technology advancement has adversely affected our environment and life styles that has manifested in new types of diseases and ailments which possess a new challenges to the medical fraternity. Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation medical Education Trust proposed Dental College in Ahmedabad region has no access to Dental health treatment & Services. The opening of a new full fledged Dental hospital in Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation Medical Education Trust proposed Dental College, Ahmedabad would cater to the needs of the vast region, who otherwise would have to come to Govt. Dental College, Ahmedabad.

Manpower specialty Dental treatment would be given which was not possible formally.

- (11) Dental Surgeon - patient ratio proposed to be achieved. : 1 : 10,000
- (12) Copy of the inspection Report in connection with the inspection carried out by the state Government for grant of permission for setting up a new dental college is to be attached.



Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation Medical Education Trust has applied for establishment of a dental college at Ahmedabad. on careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Gujarat has decided to issue an essentiality certificate to the applicant for the establishment of a dental college with 100 seats

It is certified that :-

(a) The applicant owns and manages a 400 bedded hospital known as L.G. General Hospital, Maninagar, Ahmedabad which was established under Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation,

The proposed Dental College is to be started at L. G. Hospital, Ahmedabad which is owned by Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation itself which is having provision for 440 Beds and which is located within 10 k.m. of radius of the proposed Dental College till they have their own hospital in the same premises. It shall be the duty of the applicant to produce evidence that the infrastructural facilities such as teaching, pre - clinical, para - clinical and allied medical sciences are owned by the proposed Dental College itself.

(b) The applicant has undertaken to own and manages a dental clinic with 10 chairs.

(c) It is desirable to establish a dental college in the public interest;

(d) Average 100 to 125 Out Door Dental patients per day are available to begin with,

(e) The credibility and the financial status of the applicant has been verified. It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the dental college as per Dental Council of India norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Dental Council of India the State Govt. shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of the Central Government.

This certificate is issued subject to following conditions.

1. The Trust should get NOC/affiliation from Gujarat University, Ahmedabad.



2. The Dental College building is to be constructed within a period of one year and priority should be given to establish 1st year BDS teaching department.
3. Furniture, equipments and library books of 1st DDS teaching are to be procured.
4. Recruitment of teaching faculty for 1st BDS teaching is to be completed before admission of students.
5. Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation Medical Education Trust shall give Bank Guaranty worth Rs.1 crores (One Crores) in favour of Govt. of Gujarat According to Govt.Resolution No. MCG-1097-2454-J, dt. 20-6-2001 and No:MCG-1097-2454-J, dt. 6/6/2002.
