

As an adjunct to compulsory rotating internship programme, the interns from the Department has the two months regular posting schedule at Danilimda Community Health Centre and Rakhial Community Health Centre. The students are going by themselves on their own. The students visit these centres and work under the guidance of the dentist doctor.

The Department of Public Health Dentistry, AMC Dental College and Hospital has got tie up with various Community and Urban Health Centres. For this, the two interns from the Department are posted regularly and daily on rotation basis on designated days for the respective satellite centres.

Vatva Community Health Centre	Every Monday
Vastral Community Health Centre	Every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday
Naroda Community Health Centre	Every Wednesday
Gomtipur Community Health Centre	Every Saturday
Bhaipura Urban Health Centre	Every Friday

The students are going in a mobile van daily from the department on respective dates for each centre. The students are conducting following things at centres.

- 1. Screening and diagnosis for oral diseases.
- Education regarding commonly seen dental diseases like dental caries, periodontal diseases, mal-aligned teeth, non healing ulcers and frequent ulcer in mouth.
- Detection of oral pre cancerous lesion and conditions and doing counseling for Tobacco cessation.
- Education regarding effect of systemic diseases on oral health.
- 5. Education regarding effect of oral diseases on systemic health.
- 6. Education of proper brushing techniques.
- Education regarding importance of proper diet and nutrition on oral health and oral health awareness among communities.

The residential facility is available at the centres.
