7. Offering Institute and Faculty

The Course is offered by Department of Prosthodontics & Crown and Bridge, AMC Dental College and hospital

8. Who Can Participate in the Course

Students undergoing internship at Department of Prosthodontics & Crown and Bridge, AMC Dental College can participate in the course.

9. Duration of the course: 45 hours

10. Intake Capacity

15 students in a batch for 15 days period.

11. Course Fee

There will be no fee for the course

12. Award of Certificate

The students completing 80 % attendance will be awarded the course completion certificates

13 Course Content

- i) Introduction, Scope and Importance of Geriatric dental care.
- ii) Provide knowledge that enables the care of all patients, including those with special physiologic and pathologic needs due to ageing.
- iii) Theoretical and practical contents.
- iv) Understanding and managing dental conditions prevalent in older adults.
- v) Exploring the co-relation between systemic health issues and oral health.
- vi) Learning prosthetic and rehabilitative dentistry for the elderly.
- vii) Exploring ethical dilemmas and considerations when providing dental care to elderly.
- viii) Hands-on clinical experiences and case studies.
- ix) Studying the impact of medications on oral health in geriatric patients.
- x) Comprehensive geriatric dental care.
- xi) This course provides the understanding of the components of a "function-oriented assessment" as they apply to the older adult in the dental office setting.
- xii) The following components will be addressed in order listed:
- Communication status: Ability to express, see, hear, and/or understand the provider or information presented.
- 2. Physical status: Independence in Activities of Daily Living (ADLs) and Instrumental Activities of Daily Living (IADLs).
- 3. Mobility status: Fine and gross motor abilities.
- 4. Mental status: Memory and cognitive ability.
- 5. Nutritional status: Malnutrition and dehydration.
- 6. Social support: Ability to engage assistance needed.
- 7. Medical status and consultation: Ability to medically tolerate the procedure.
