The summary of activities organized by **Department of Prosthodontics and crown and bridge** is as under:

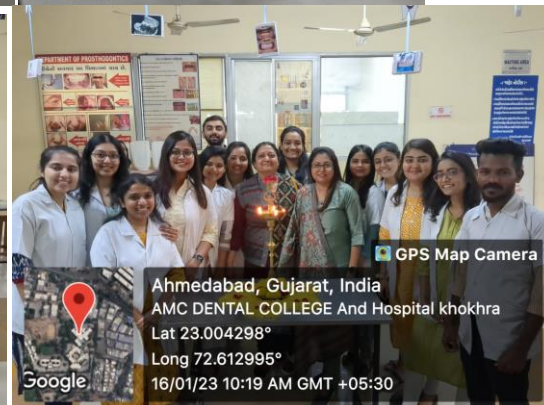
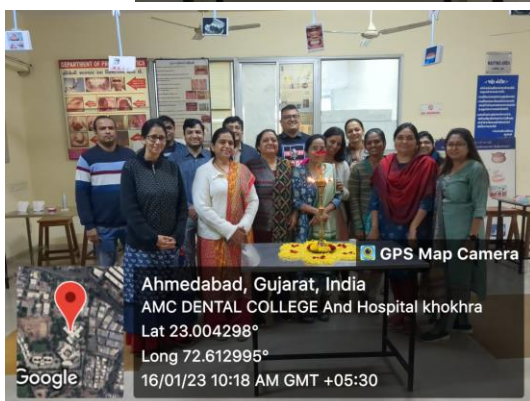
Activity - 1
