## ORAL MEDICINE & RADIOLOGY DEPT, CELEBRATION OF NO TOBACCO DAY ON 31<sup>ST</sup> MAY YEAR 2024

Department of oral medicine and radiology had organized an awareness program on the harmful effects of tobacco and betel nut use, on 31<sup>st</sup> May 2024.

In the morning session, 'Awareness skit' was performed by the intern doctors of the department, mainly highlighting the triggers/risk factors of the addiction and creating awareness and motivating them to quit the habit. In the drama we explained the people how once being diagnosed by cancer begins the suffering. Cancer causes loss of life also effects financially and emotionally to the family. We explained in detail about first hand, second hand, third hand smoking side effect. The motivation led them to raise their hands saying they will quit this bad habit from today. There was also "Awareness photo booth" for encouraging patients to quit habit.

All the patients were assessed in our awareness camp for the destructive oral habits and screened for the habit related potentially malignant disorders and squamous cell carcinoma. Posters and models of the oral lesions, made in regional language, were used to create awareness among them about the harmful effects of tobacco and betel nut. The patients who required medicinal management for the oral lesions were given free medications. Total 140 patients got benefited through the camp. We also did velscope screening camp for precancerous lesion.

Then we counseled patients in our OPD all the day motivating them to quit tobacco.
